RWU Resolution to Bring Brother Kilmar Home

Whereas, legally protected immigrant worker and SMART Union member Kilmar Armando Abrego Garcia was deported without required due process to a foreign mega prison,

Whereas, Brother Kilmar held specific legal protection against deportation that had not been changed,

Whereas, Bro. Kilmar is not legally accused of any crime, or action,

Whereas, a Federal Judge has ruled, and the United States Supreme Court has supported that there was no legal evidence supporting his deportation,

Whereas, extremists in the Federal Executive branch have now repeatedly disobeyed lawful court instructions, and made documented false statements, threatening other legal rights,

Whereas, the SMART Union, alongside many allies, have made the defense and return of their brother, a member of SMART Local 100, a key part of the defense of the right to due process upon which we all depend,

Whereas, every Union railroad worker knows what happens when there is no due process and only the bosses decide,

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that Railroad Workers United joins the international calls for the swift and safe return of Bro. Kilmar, supported by the United States Supreme Court, as an elementary obligation of all serious defenders of the right to due process.

Be It Further Resolved, that RWU calls upon all members and railroad workers to join and support public defense of our brothers and sisters who were not born in the U.S. and are now illegally targeted by a reckless Government whose actions threaten basic American rights and freedoms.
